A Proposed Narrative of the Baptism Ritual

Baptismal Candidate:

I believe I have sinned before God. I believe God sent His Son to die for my sins. I believe He will forgive my sin if I repent of my sin. I am sorry for sin and will try not to sin any more. I would like to be baptized in the water and to take the name of God and then rise out of the water to the newness of life – a new creature in Christ, wearing His robe of righteousness, bearing His name and ready to be filled with His Spirit.

Baptizer:

Because you have declared your faith in the redeeming work of Christ and acknowledged and repented of your sins and asked to be buried with Christ in the washing of regeneration: I now baptize you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost which is Jesus the messiah. (Candidate is now submerged.) I now name you with God's name 'Yahshuah' meaning 'I Am is become salvation. and I remit your sins.' (Candidate now is lifted from under the water.) You now bear the name of God, 'Yahshuah.'
